MOTION OF STAFF OF THE ONTARIO SECURITIES COMMISSION

A. ORDER SOUGHT

The Moving Party, Staff ("**Staff**") of the Ontario Securities Commission (the "**Commission**"), request with notice, that the Commission make the following orders:

- An Order, if necessary, permitting Staff to file the decision of the Division of Trading and Markets of the United States Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC") dated October 9, 2019, Release No. 34-87267 (the "SEC Decision") on the application for a proposed rule change relating to the listing and trading of shares of the Bitwise Bitcoin ETF Trust ("Bitwise ETF");
- 2. If necessary, an Order permitting Staff to reopen its case for the purpose of filing the fresh evidence of the SEC Decision referred to in paragraph 1; and
- 3. Such further and other relief as to this Commission may seem just.

B. GROUNDS

The grounds for the motion are:

- 4. At the hearing and review of this matter, 3iQ Corp. and The Bitcoin Fund (collectively, the "Applicants") relied on a presentation¹ ("Bitwise Presentation") and paper² ("Bitwise Paper") filed in support of the application before the SEC relating to the Bitwise ETF;
- 5. The Applicants argued that the Bitwise Presentation and Bitwise Paper should be accorded significant weight by the Panel because these documents were submitted to the SEC as part of a process to obtain approval for the Bitwise ETF;
- 6. On October 9, 2019, the SEC released the SEC Decision;
- 7. In the SEC Decision, the SEC commented on and/or made determinations in relation to a number of conclusions contained in the Bitwise Presentation and the Bitwise Paper that are being relied on by the Applicants in this matter;
- 8. The SEC Decision is relevant to the issues and matter before the Panel;
- 9. The Panel has not yet rendered its decision on the matter before it;
- 10. The Panel should have the benefit of reviewing the SEC's analysis of the conclusions contained in the Bitwise Presentation and the Bitwise Paper before rendering its decision in this matter;
- 11. The SEC Decision was not available to Staff in July 2019 when Staff closed its case; and
- 12. Such further and other grounds as counsel may advise and this Commission may permit.

C. EVIDENCE:
